Greetings! The Batavia Mothers' Club continues to provide support and attention to our community through various fundraisers and volunteer efforts. We started our year with our annual Winter Coat drive where we collected coats and winter gear for adults and children and donated hams for the Batavia Interfaith Food Pantry.

The fall is a busy time for the Club as we prepared for our 33rd annual Craft Show, our largest fundraiser that was held at the Batavia High School on October 20. We hosted over 100 crafters and vendors as well as organized a bake sale and raffle. Through generous donations from our sponsors and sales through our talented participants, we raised close to \$17,000 which will be disbursed back to the community.

The holidays brought another opportunity for giving back. Each year, the club participates in the Christmas Families program through the Batavia United Way. Through this effort, we adopted 30 children and 10 families and provided them with needed clothes and toys for the holidays. We also volunteered in the Batavia Access Toy drive which made some children's Christmas a little brighter.

We kicked off 2019 with our Totally Rad 80's Bunco held on January 12 at the Batavia Moose Lodge. It was a successful and fun night where participants and club members decked out in neon jammed to 80's music and played through 3 rounds of Bunco! This event raised over \$4000 for our community.

Our last fundraiser of the year, the 19th annual Fox Trot Run/Walk is scheduled for Saturday, April 27. Get out your running shoes and come on out for a run along the scenic Fox River Trail. Additional race course for a kid's fun run is also planned. All money raised through the Fox Trot as well as any other fundraisers throughout the year go directly to Batavia Schools and local organizations through our spring disbursements. We continue to help improve the lives of children and families of the Fox Valley area.

I am honored to work alongside a hardworking and committed group of women that dedicate their time to making our community a better place to live. We owe a lot of our success as an organization to the relationships we have built with local businesses and individuals who share in our mission to provide for those in need.

# Philanthropy

FULFILLING OUR MISSION

Batavia Mothers' Club members have put countless hours giving back to our community through philanthropic efforts this fall and winter. In our first donation of the year, we sent each of the twenty-three novice teachers in the Batavia School District a \$20 gift card to Amazon and a "welcome to Batavia" letter. Welcoming new teachers and was a great start to the year!

September 21st through October 5th brought our annual Coat and Clothing Drive. Bins were placed at all of the Batavia Public Schools, Immanuel Lutheran School, Holy Cross School, the Batavia Public Library, the Batavia Park District's Civic Center and East Side Community Center, Meadow View Veterinary Clinic, Hanson Chiropractic, Orangetheory Fitness Geneva, and Batavia Nursery School. BMCF was able to collect and sort more than 450 coats and winter accessories. Everything collected went to the Batavia Interfaith Clothes Closet. Batavia's amazing generosity has helped keep many kids warm this winter. Thank you to everyone who donated winter gear!

In November, we collected hams for the Interfaith Food Pantry. This yearly collection allows families to have a traditional Thanksgiving Dinner. This year we collected over \$100 to purchase hams. The Food Pantry was grateful for this donation.

Through the Christmas Families program in December we were able to provide gifts and clothing for 30 children from 10 families who otherwise may have gone without presents. Each family was also given a family gift to help them spend time together. We were privileged to partner with Batavia United Way for this program. BMCF members outdid





In addition to supporting these programs, our members have also made personal contributions to local organizations at our monthly meetings. Supported programs include: the Batavia ACCESS Toy Drive, Chip In, Go With the Flow Parties, Hesed House, and Mutual Ground.

In May, we will distribute the funds raised by the Batavia Mother's Club Foundation throughout the year to groups that share our mission on improving the lives of women and families in our community. A disbursement reception will be held to allow members from our organization to meet representatives from the educational and nonprofit organizations whose projects we are helping to fund and to learn more about those projects.
