Philanthropy

FULFILLING OUR MISSION

Batavia Mothers' Club members have put countless hours giving back to our community through philanthropic efforts this fall and winter. In September, we provided gifts to each of the novice teachers who were beginning their first year in the Batavia school system. Twenty novice teachers received a \$20 gift certificate to Target and a "welcome to Batavia" letter. Welcoming new teachers and supporting a local business was a great start to the year!

October also brought our annual Coat and Clothing Drive. Bins were placed at all of the Batavia Public Schools, the Batavia Public Library, the Batavia Park District Civic Center, Immanuel Lutheran School, Meadow View Veterinary Clinic, and Batavia Nursery School. BMCF was able to collect and sort more than 400 coats and winter accessories. Everything collected was donated in late October to the Batavia Interfaith Clothes Closet. Batavia's amazing generosity has helped keep many kids warm this winter. Thank you to everyone who donated winter gear!

In November, we collected hams for the Interfaith Food Pantry. This yearly collection allows families to have a traditional Thanksgiving Dinner. This year we collected more than 12 hams. The Food Pantry was very grateful for this donation.

December was one of our busier months. Our Christmas Families program was able to provide gifts and clothing for 30 children and parents who otherwise may have gone without presents. We were privileged to partner with Batavia United Way for this program. BMCF members outdid themselves with their generosity this year!





In addition to supporting these programs, our members have also made personal contributions to local organizations such as Batavia ACCESS Toy Drive, Chip In, Lazarus House, Batavia Interfaith Food Pantry, and Mutual Ground.

As winter closes we spend our efforts on applications for financial disbursements, first distributing to then collecting completed applications from area schools and community organizations. In May we will have the honor of disbursing the funds raised this year to groups that share our mission of improving our community. A disbursement reception will be held to allow members from our organization to meet representatives from the educational and nonprofit organizations whose projects we are helping to fund and to learn more about those projects.
